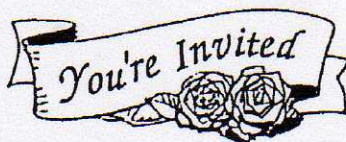

Eucharistic Adoration at St. Teresa

Pope Benedict XVI has asked all Catholic parishes to provide Eucharistic Adoration in their Churches. A Dogma of our Faith is that Jesus is physically present in the Eucharist and it is important for us to spend time in worship and praise of God. **All are encouraged to spend some time in Church each week in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament.** We are blessed in having several opportunities for Adoration.

Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday from 3pm until 7pm the Church is locked, but Adoration of our Lord in the Tabernacle occurs. Those attending receive a key card (contact the Parish Office), enabling them to enter Church. Jack & Mary Barnhorn coordinate Adoration, call them at 471-2103 to sign up for a 1 hour time slot. We desire at least 2 people in Church during these hours. This is a beautiful, quiet time to pray for the world, your family, and be with God.

On Friday from 12:30 to 1:30pm and Saturday from 7:25 to 8:25am the Blessed Sacrament is in the Monstrance on the Main Altar. This is a Holy Hour of Prayer, ending with Benediction at 1:30pm & 8:25am. Come receive this Special Blessing of God.

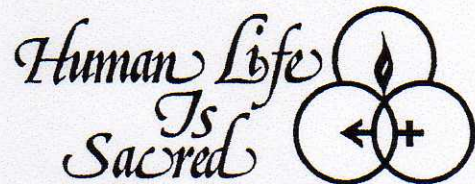
