



Change In Registration for 2017-18 PSR Classes

Greetings Everyone,

First, I am very appreciative of the many parents who have sent well-wishes since my retirement announcement. I have been blessed since joining the parish staff in 2006 to work alongside so many dedicated people sharing a common goal of bringing others to Christ—thank you.

As the parish looks for a new coordinator for our Regional PSR, I want to give some direction concerning the **changes in registering your children for the 2017-18 school year**.

The past few years any family with children previously enrolled in PSR have been able to simply email their intention to continue classes the next year (even though they have still been required to submit a new *Medical Release Form* for that year). Unfortunately, since I will no longer be coordinating that information and my replacement is not yet in place, everyone will need to return to the hard copy registration for the 2017-18 school year.

By the first of June, I will have updated the *Registration, Emergency Medical Release Form* and the *PSR Handbook* on the parish website. You will need to print the forms and mail them (along with the fee) to the parish office to enroll your child in class by August 18 to reserve a place for your child in class. The parish office will collect the registration forms and, when the new coordinator is appointed, he or she will contact you with the 2017-18 class schedules.

My last day as coordinator is July 7, 2017. If I can be of help in the next few weeks, please contact me.
